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# Appendix 1

## Mary Kwar, MS, OTR

Mary Kawar, MS, OTR, a private practitioner in San Diego, California for over 18 years, has specialized in programs for children and adults with learning disabilities. She was director of occupational therapy for 18 years at Children's Hospital in San Diego. Mary has been particularly successful at designing treatment to improve vestibular and ocular motor abilities. She has lectured widely in the area of sensory integration.

Mary Kawar, is credited as the single most significant contributor to introducing Infinity Walk to occupational therapists through her teaching and writing on Oculomotor Control. Mary has personally introduced Infinity Walk to over 2000 occupational therapists during international teaching tours. She also cited Infinity Walk as one of her top two picks for oculomotor-vestibular-proprioceptive intervention in "Sensory Integration: Theory and Practice (2<sup>nd</sup> edition)".
